SUBJECT: FY04 Master/Senior Recruiting Badge Criteria #2

TO: All Recruiting Service Personnel

1. The purpose of this PGM is to outline Master/Senior Recruiting Badge eligibility for FY2004. **This PGM supersedes PGM 005, dated 20 Jul 04.**

2. In order to determine award of a master/senior badge for this fiscal year in EA programs, goals through 30 Apr 04 will be used with production through 30 Sep 04. Any pure cancellation that occurred from 1 May 04 through 30 Sep 04 does not count. Do not count any enlistments that were cancelled and re-booked as two NET reservations. The following criteria will be used for the EA Senior Recruiting Badge:

(a). **EA Recruiter** - If an EA recruiter was at 115% of NET RES goal on 30 Sep 04, award the Senior Recruiting Badge. If an EA Recruiter was 100% of NET RES goal on 30 Sep 04 and had at least 5 applicants on the QW qualified and listing any of the AFSC in paragraph 3, award the Senior Recruiting Badge. If an EA Recruiter doesn't meet this criteria, you may submit the attached exception to policy through your group for consideration at AFRS with AFRS/RSO making the final decision for award of the Senior Recruiting Badge.

(b). **EA Flight Chief** - If an EA flight Chief was 115% of NET RES goal with all eligible recruiters at least 100% of goal by 30 Sep 04, award the Senior Recruiting Badge. Any variance to this scenario (i.e. considering Q&W, below 115% etc.) should be treated as an ETP and forwarded through your group for consideration at AFRS with AFRS/RSO making the final decision for award of the Senior Recruiting Badge.

(c). **Out of Cycle Recruiters/Flight Chiefs** - If a recruiter or flight chief completed their 9th to 12th month on goal as of 30 Apr 04, were 115% of NET RES goal or better and met all other criteria, award the Senior Recruiting Badge. For those that would have completed their 12th month from May through September, consider their production at that time or use FY04 production numbers through 30 Sep 04 and include RTP statistics for Senior Recruiting Badge consideration. Any variance to this scenario should be treated as an ETP and forwarded through your group for consideration at AFRS with AFRS/RSO making the final decision for award of the Senior Recruiting Badge.

3. The following AFSC will be used to determine if Q&W applicants will be considered for Senior Recruiting Badge production: **1A031, 1A131, 1A231, 1A331, 1A431, 1A531, 1A731, 1A831, 1C131, 1C231, 1N031, 1N131, 1N231, 1N330, 1N431, 1N531, 1N631, 1T031, 1T231, 1W031, 2A031, 2A331, 2A332, 2A333, 2A531, 2A532, 2A533, 2A631, 2A632, 2A633, 2A634, 2A635, 2A636, 2A731, 2A733, 2A734, 2E031, 2E131, 2E132, 2E133, 2E134, 2E231, 2F031, 2M031, 2M032, 2M033, 2T231, 2T331, 2T332, 2T334, 2T335, 2W031, 2W131, 2W231, 3C031, 3C032, 3E032, 3E231, 3E331, 3E431, 3E432, 3E831, 3P031, 9S100, 9TE67, 9TG58, 9TM44, 9TM51, 9TM55**

4. The Master Recruiter badge may be awarded by groups and squadrons to either an EA or OA recruiter for this fiscal year.

5. There are no changes to the OA Senior Recruiting Badge criteria/eligibility.
