SUBJECT: Interim Change to AFRSI 36-2201 (AFRS Training Program)

TO: All AFRS

1. The purpose of this PGM is to immediately implement two paragraphs from the new AFRSI 36-2201 that will be in the field at a later time.

- Change 1. Paragraph 8.4. will now read: Ensure all required supplemental training is provided for subordinates and is properly documented. Newly assigned EA or OA recruiters will receive a minimum of 5 full workdays of critical task training within the first 30 days of assignment from their flight chief (or someone selected by the squadron superintendent if no flight chief is assigned).
- Change 2. Paragraph 25.1. will now read: New recruiters will not be goaled for the calendar month of the date assigned station (DAS), regardless of the date. The first full calendar month, they will be given a goal of zero; the second full calendar month, they will be given a goal of one; and the third full calendar month, they will begin receiving a goal according to the flight goaling operating instruction (OI). These goals will be closely monitored by each RCS/RST and reported to RCG/RST. The RTP will end at the end of the second full calendar month after arrival.

2. Again, this change to AFRSI 36-2201 is to be implemented immediately.
