SUBJECT: Retesting Minimally Qualified Delayed Entry Program (DEP) Members

TO: All Operations/MEPS Personnel

1. **This PGM supersedes PGM 201 dated 12 Mar 02.**
2. You are authorized to DEP discharge and retest any member of the DEP who resides on the Qualified and Waiting (Q&W) list for insufficient or minimally qualifying line scores. The following ground rules apply:
 - a. The applicant must elect to be discharged from the DEP for the purpose of obtaining a higher AFQT or better qualifying line score. They must understand they will be disqualified for Air Force enlistment should their score fall below a 36 QT, and/or their line scores may/may not be considered for an ASVAB waiver for scores between AFQT 26-35. Ensure they are eligible to retest IAW current minimum time requirements. There will not be exceptions to policy for invalid retests when errors are made in calculating the applicant's eligibility for a retest.
 - b. Upon successfully improving their score, they will be expected to accept a job reservation based on Air Force needs and re-enter the DEP.
 - c. In the event their scores drops below a 36QT, they are subject to the published minimum wait times before retesting.
