SUBJECT: Marijuana Use After Signing AF Form 2030

TO: All Recruiting Personnel

1. There have been several questions about processing former applicants (to include DEPPERS) who have used marijuana since stopping the application process (to include Job cancellation and DEP Discharge), and wish to enter the AF.
2. The AF Form 2030 states that "...any drug use or abuse as described above, FROM THIS DATE FORWARD, renders me ineligible for the Air Force." AFI/AETCI 36-2002 also states that marijuana usage after signing the AF Form 2030 makes the applicant ineligible for enlistment or waiver consideration. The intent of the AF Form 2030 and AFI/AETCI was to deter applicants, awaiting processing and in DEP, from using marijuana or any other drug.
3. Once an applicant withdraws his/her application (PIR is closed and has had their job reservation cancelled and been DEP discharged, if applicable) they are no longer "applicants." Pending the revision of AF Form 2030 and the instructions, returning applicants who have used marijuana after withdrawing his/her application and wishes to join the AF are eligible for an Air Staff Exception To Policy (ETP).
