SUBJECT: Elimination of Addendum to AF Form 1437, Flight Commander Interview for MC, DC, NC, MSC, and BSC applications

TO: All AFRS Officer Accessions Personnel

1. This message provides guidance for the elimination of the requirement for the Addendum to AF Form 1437, Flight Commander Interview.
2. The Addendum to AF Form 1437, Flight Commander Interview, is no longer required for MC, DC, NC, MSC and BSC applications. Flight commander interviews will still be required for all HPSP applications. To ensure applications are consistent, the following implementation schedule will be used (Addendums will not be required as of the board indicated):

 MC: 05MC03
 DC: 05DC02
 NC: 05NC02
 MSC: any board held after 05MSC01
 BSC: 05BSC02
3. Flight commanders should remain an active participant in the recruiting process by meeting with all applicants, discussing the advantages of a career as an Air Force health professional, and ensuring all applicants understand the unique challenges associated with being an Air Force Officer. The elimination of the requirement for the flight commander interview also does not prohibit the flight commander from providing input to the selection boards on an issue that should be clarified or brought to the boards' attention.
